The successful candidate will be assigned to the Financial Institutions team within Credit Risk Management and tasks may include the following:

- Creating ad-hoc risk management tools to help in the analysis of Swiss Re's credit risk to key insurance and financial industry names;
- Assisting in the development of tools to identify and analyze key risks within the portfolio, and identify areas that warrant additional review;
- Establish processes that enhance the delivery of key risk information to senior risk managers and constituents external to FRM; which can be both one-off and perennial in order to best leverage information within the credit risk reporting system; and
- Prepare ad hoc analysis related to certain market conditions as they pertain to credit risk taking by Swiss Re.
