Mr. Gorski manages a staff of six full time staff and is currently responsible and accountable for the organization's workers' compensation, loss control, casualty, property and litigation management needs. This includes establishing risk financing objectives through the analysis of appropriate levels risk retention, risk transfer, alternative risk financing options, and budgetary concerns.

Mr. Gorski is currently the outgoing Chairman of the American Public Transportation Association's (APTA) Risk Management Committee. He is also the Past President of the Orange County Risk and Insurance Management Society (OCRIMS) and was awarded the Ron Judd Heart of RIMS Award for 2008. In 2005, Mr. Gorski was nominated for Business Insurance Magazine's Risk Manager of the year and received the Honor Roll Award for his work with the Orange County Transportation Authority.

Mr. Gorski is also an award winning Adjunct Professor at California State University, Fullerton and teaches Principles of Insurance and Commercial Insurance courses. In addition, he is a regularly featured public speaker on subjects ranging from litigation strategy, complex insurance solutions, workers' compensation cost-saving strategies and loss data analysis technology.
